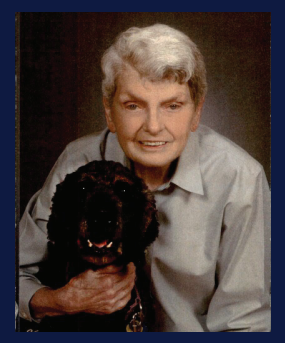

YOU - thank you for playing your part!

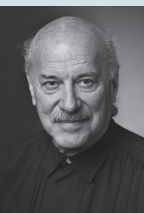
What is the Young Artist Program?

The Young Artists are students from prestigious conservatories who
perform in concerts and make lasting contributions to Music in Schools.
Last year you met and loved the Dolphins from Juilliard; they are coming
back! This year we will be introduced to a new group, the Vizsla Quartet
from Curtis.

What is Music in Schools?

With the belief that every child's life is enriched by music, Music
in Schools takes the Young Artists (each August) and New
Mexico collegiate musicians (spring) to schools in the area. The
K-12 students enjoy short concerts and rehearsing side-by-side
with the Young Artists. When you support Music from Angel Fire,

Who is the Composer in Residence?



Marc Neikrug has been the Artistic Director of the
Santa Fe Chamber Music Festival since 1998. He
enjoyed a 40 year career as a pianist, notably as a duo
partner with Pinchas Zukerman. His compositions
have been performed by major festivals, orchestras,
and opera houses around the world. Recent
compositions include his fourth symphony, for the
Elbephilharmonie, and his second piano quintet,
premiered at the Kennedy Center. He lives in Northern
new Mexico with his wife Dolly, and they now have five
grandchildren and two great grandsons.

Who is the visual artist?

Sharon L. Sorensen's artwork is a combination of carefully composed poetic movement of line and watercolor. Many of her artworks start as en plein air (on location outdoors). The contour (continuous) line drawing adds another dimension, producing a unique style. Her paintings incorporate a drafting and technical background to capture the beauty and soul of the landscape in realistic and abstract works.

Sharon had a lifelong interest in art, design, and architecture. She earned a Bachelor's degree in Environmental Design from the University of Colorado. Upon graduating, her first jobs included drafting and environmental planning. Over the years, she has taught children and adult art classes. She has formed two art companies specializing in painting murals. Commissions have included wall murals, architectural and interior renderings, landscapes, and abstract paintings. Her paintings grace the wall and homes of many private collectors worldwide.

She hopes her paintings evoke wonder and provide insight into the amazing world we live in-blessed and inspired by God's beautiful creation.
